GEORGE BOYACK PROJECT GUIDELINES

Sensory Quilts:

- lap size, approximately 20" wide and 16" long.
- square, oval, round, octagonal, etc. shapes fine too.
- can be crazy quilt style, or whatever you come up with.
- theme SQ's are particularly stimulating.
- variety of textures is very suitable.
- think colourful, but bland is OK if you use suede, fur, velvet, silk, metallic, fleece.
- embellishments are wonderful! They must be securely attached.

Wheelchair Quilts:

- 36 – 45" wide (depends on what fabric you have to work with).
- 45 – 52" long (ditto)
- these are just guidelines: a variety of sizes will be great.

Indoor weight:

- fleece, minkee, polar fleece (rag quilts are good).
- double layer of flannel or cotton & flannel.

Outdoor weight:

- traditional quilt sandwich (two cottons or flannels & batting).
- polar fleece & quilters' cotton.
- polar fleece & flannel or denim.
- whatever you have that's washable. These are just ideas.

Toiletries Totes:

- tote style with handles, like a gift bag.
- 8" x 10" to 12" x 16" or whatever you have on hand.
- lined or serged – they'll be laundered a lot.
- terry, flannel, cotton, nylon, denim, or whatever you have.
- padded handles are great (batting or soft cord in the middle) for some of the seniors to carry. Others will be hooked over walker handles and won't require padding.
